Greetings,

First of all, I would like to take the time to thank all of you for your support of me through the years. God has been very good to me through these last few years at Pensacola Christian College. Life is full of new adventures. I remember coming down here for the first time in the fall of 2006. Grandma and Grandpa left to return home and for the first time I was alone. Everything was new and strange and at first I was very afraid. But, God was faithful and saw me through five years at PCC. Finally, after a lot of hard work and some tears I was awarded my degree.

Recently, God has given me another great opportunity for adventure. Brother John Lawrence from the International Board of Jewish Missions preached at our annual Missions conference at Clear Springs Baptist Church. He mentioned a trip to Buenos Aires Argentina. I started praying about the possibility of going as I felt the Lord leading me to apply. I filled out my application and thankfully I was accepted to be on the team.

Through the trip, I will be able to have several opportunities to serve the Lord. Argentina is one of the biggest Jewish mission fields in the world. Argentina has a Jewish population of over 200,000 Jews. The team will meet in Hixson Tennessee on May 30-31 for training. Then on the 1<sup>st</sup> of June through the 11<sup>th</sup> we will minister in Argentina. The areas of service will include: Bible distribution, tract distribution, and one-on-one witness opportunities. They are also hosting an Honor Israel event, along with Open-Air evangelism in Jewish neighborhoods, and ministering in Spanish-speaking churches and children's home.

First and foremost, I would like to ask you to pray for the lost Jewish people of Argentina. The Jewish people are the nearest people to God's heart and He loves to see them saved. Also, pray for God to put together a good team to carry on the work he has called us to do. Finally, since this is a mission's outreach, it is necessary that I raise support. If you would like to help, the cost of the trip is \$2295. This covers roundtrip airfare, hotel accommodations, meals, public transportation, and specialized training sessions on May 30-31. Would you prayerfully consider helping in any way as I carry the gospel to the lost Jews of Argentina?
